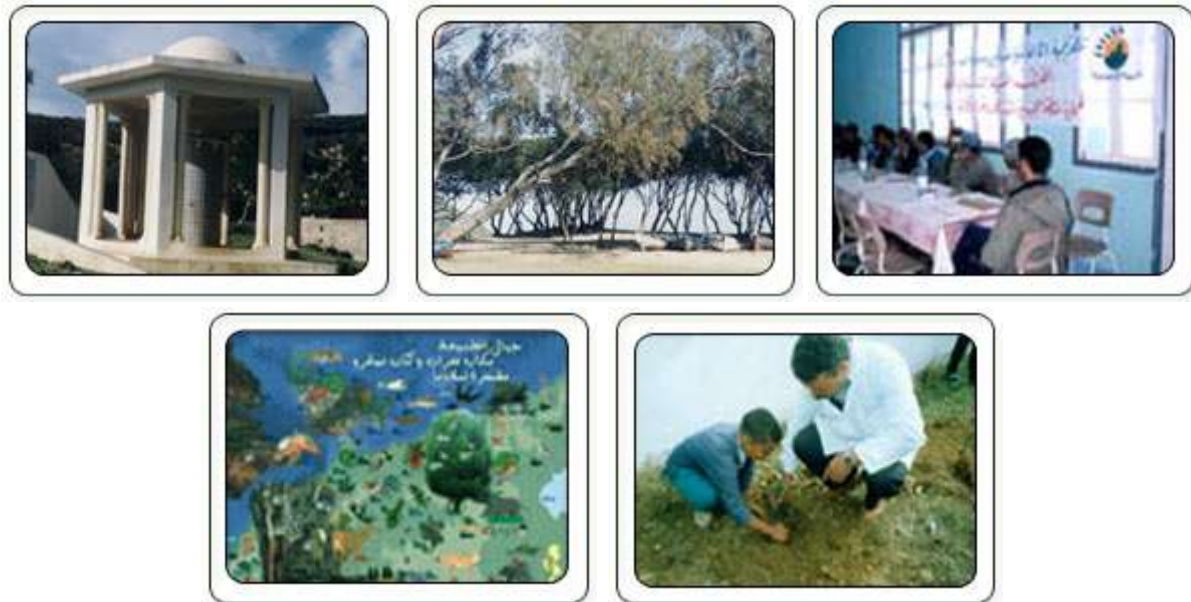


Project: initiative to raise awareness of participatory conservation in the region of Cap Serrat - Cap Nègro



Period: from July 2000 to June 2001

Project: awareness Initiative of the participatory conservation of the region Serrât Cap-Cap Nègro.

The aim of this project is to increase appreciation of the ecological, cultural, social values and contribute to the development and participatory conservation of forest and marine areas in -Cap Cap Serrat Negro on environmental education for different public groups, including schoolchildren, teachers and the local population

Goals:

- Awareness of the local population on conservation and development of the region.
- Establishment of an environmental education program in primary schools in the region.
- The establishment, equipping and running of environmental clubs in schools across the region.
- Developing a diagnostic program of potential forest resources, marine and fisheries in the region.
- Organization of workshops on active methods of research and participatory planning for the conservation and the development of the region.
- The organization of information days and training for teachers and, foresters and sailors technicians from the region on the various tools of environmental education for the Protection of Forest and Marines Resources.
- The preparation of a plan of action for the continuation and development of future projects for the conservation and development of the region using the results of Workshops.
